



## **The Landings New Neighbors, Inc. and The Landings Club Usage**

**New Neighbors utilizes The Landings Club facilities for some of our activities and special events. When activities use Club facilities, Club rules must be followed and the Landings Club Guest Policy observed for non-club members. Activities or events subject to Landings Club restrictions will be designated by “Club” in the activity calendar**

- **Catered Events.** All New Neighbors can attend catered events at club facilities. This includes the Annual Social, Luncheons, Cocktail receptions and any NN activity that contracts with the Club for space. Registration and payment for these events is via the NN Sign-Up process. Non-Club members can attend 12 catered events a year. A cash bar is available to non-club members at these events.
- **Card Room Play.** Non-Club members will not be able to participate in card room play held in one of the Club’s card rooms unless there is a catered meal in conjunction with the activity. Activity Chairs are responsible for enforcing this policy around card room play. The Club reserves the right to deny privileges or impose fees for violations.
- **Cabana Bar, The Deck, Deer Creek Patio, and Restaurant Dining.** The Landings New Neighbors, Inc. is not a member of The Landings Club and, therefore, cannot host individuals at these venues. New Neighbors who are non-club members are permitted to participate if they are sponsored and accompanied by a Club member. Non-Club members are limited to 12 visits per year for a la carte dining.
- **Golf and Court Sports.** Athletic Club level members may participate only in Court Sports. Full Club members may participate in any sport. New Neighbors who are not members of The Club may participate as a guest of a Club Athletic or Full/Golf member up to six times per year with the appropriate Guest Fees or may utilize a Limited Golf Package in the same manner. The names of Guests using Limited Golf Packages cannot be added to New Neighbors’ tee time requests but must be added as guests and will be registered at time of use. All Guests must be accompanied by a member and be registered at time of use.
- **Food and Drink at Club Facilities.** When holding a New Neighbors event at a Club facility, all food and beverages must be purchased through the Club. No outside food or beverages may be carried into the Club.
